

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (AAS)

College majors that offer an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree are also known as “career technical” programs. AAS degree programs prepare students for direct entry into the workforce. An AAS may also help students with career growth, licenses, or further study in a bachelor’s degree program. MHCC has many transfer agreements (<http://www.mhcc.edu/AlphaMajor/>) with universities for students who have completed an AAS degree.

Human Relations

Three (3) credits:

To fulfill the Human Relations requirement for an AAS degree, students may complete 3 or more credits of the following:

- One (1) Arts & Letters (<https://catalog.mhcc.edu/degree-certificate-requirements/aaot/#arts-letters>) course, 3-4 credits, if taken summer 2019 or later.
- One (1) Social Science (<https://catalog.mhcc.edu/degree-certificate-requirements/aaot/#social>) course, 3-4 credits, if taken summer 2019 or later.
- A minimum of three (3) credits from the following:

Career-Technical Core Requirements

Complete all required core courses in a career-technical curriculum. Some programs require prerequisite coursework or placement test levels before beginning the curriculum. Check individual program pages for information.

To be awarded an AAS degree, students must:

- Complete all requirements to total 90 applicable degree credits.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher in: the cumulative MHCC grade point average; all courses being applied toward the degree; and in the candidate's major classes. Some majors may have additional GPA requirements.
- Satisfactorily earn 12 credit hours at MHCC. Non-traditional credit (College Level Examination Program, Experience-Based Credit, Challenge, etc.) does not satisfy this requirement.

Please note: Courses may not be repeated for credit unless specified in the course description.
