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Health care workers are in great demand. The Basic Health Care certificate allows students to enter the work force with the basic skills and knowledge they need for entry level health care jobs. Those in the health care field need to have skills in: being good with people, patience, communication, teamwork, and basic math and science.

During the first two terms, students enroll in courses that help them enhance their foundational and soft skills. In the third term, students focus on workplace skills by choosing one of three options: CNA, Sterile Processing Technician, or Medical Intake.

All core courses (MA/MO) must be completed within 5 years in order for the certificate to be awarded.

Program Outcomes

At the completion of this program, students should be able to:

- Identify the requirements to work as a professional in related health care environments
- Identify needed abilities to function effectively at an entry in the health care setting
- Describe technical skills needed to work effectively and safely in their chosen health care track

General education courses (such as math, writing, health, etc.) can be taken during any term, or before starting the program.
