Criminal justice is a term that includes the study of laws, procedures, institutions, and policies that are involved before, during, and after a crime occurs. In the U.S., the criminal justice system can be broken down into three areas: law enforcement; the court system; and corrections. Some jobs in the field require an associate degree or higher, and some may need a four year degree. This major prepares students to transfer to a four year program while also earning an associate degree.

- Explain how the criminal justice system functions and fits into the overall U.S. society
- Compare and contrast the various theories of why people offend
- Compare and contrast the structure and function of the federal and state court system
- Compare and contrast the various goals of punishment
- Explain the value of prison treatment programs as well as community corrections
