Students that complete the first year of the Photography program may also earn this Career Pathway Certificate (CPCC). It provides students with the basic tools and processes needed for working in the creative field.

Adobe Creative Cloud software (Lightroom, Photoshop, Dreamweaver, Acrobat) is taught in order for students to: prepare image files for printing; prepare images for online display; and manipulate, retouch and resize images.

Students can continue on into a second year to earn the AAS in Photography, where students develop more advanced skills, including digital video.

All core (IM, CP) courses must be completed within 10 years in order for the certificate to be awarded.
