MHCC's Theatre Arts Transfer Degree is for students who plan to transfer to a four-year college to major or minor in theatre. Students will complete courses that apply toward the first two years of a bachelor's degree. Course topics include acting, set design, costumes, lighting, and more. All theatre majors are invited to participate in theatre productions to balance classroom learning with practical experience. MHCC Theatre presents full-scale productions each year in two theatres. MHCC's College Theatre seats 500 and has state-of-the-art rigging and lighting. MHCC's Studio Theatre seats 99 and is a flexible space for students to create and learn.
